

# FY 2020-21 Annual Action Plan – Minor Amendment

As a participating jurisdiction in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, the City of Fountain Valley receives annual funding to support programs based on goals and projects established in the City’s approved five-year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plans (AAP). From time to time, the City is required to amend these plans when approved projects and/or activities are added, changed or cancelled.

The Fountain Valley City Council has approved the establishment of a Social Services Outreach Program for Seniors to provide information, referral services and case management to seniors that have been effected by COVID-19. The City of Fountain Valley’s Citizen Participation Plan allows funds to be allocated to emergency response (COVID-19 is a declared emergency) with the approval of the Authorized Representative without triggering a substantial amendment. The City Manager, as the Authorized Representative, approved the allocation of funds, and his approval was confirmed by City Council on October 6, 2020.

A minor amendment to the AAP has been completed adding the new program to the FY 2020-21 AAP in compliance with HUD regulations. The new activity will be reflected in the AAP as shown below.
