

## FY 2020-21 Annual Action Plan – Minor Amendment #2

As a participating jurisdiction in the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, the City of Fountain Valley receives annual funding to support programs based on goals and projects established in the City’s approved five-year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plans (AAP). From time to time, the City is required to amend these plans when approved projects and/or activities are added, changed or cancelled.

On February 16, 2021, the Fountain Valley City Council approved Amendment #2 adding an additional \$90,000 to the Public Service Agency budget in order to 1) Provide a total of \$60,000 in supplemental funding to PSA grant recipients to reimburse costs they incurred due to COVID-19 and 2) Provide \$30,000 to Meals on Wheels Congregate Lunch Program to offset raw food costs incurred due to COVID-19. The \$90,000 in new PSA funding will be transferred from surplus funds in the Home Improvement Program budget that will not be used prior to year-end. The City of Fountain Valley’s Citizen Participation Plan allows funds to be re-allocated between approved programs without triggering a substantial amendment. A minor amendment to the AAP has been completed showing the transfer of funds in compliance with HUD regulations. It should be noted that funding PSA’s above the traditional 15% cap is allowable under the CARES Act for FY 20-21. The new activity will be reflected in the AAP as shown below.
