## APPLY FOR THE MEASURE M TAXPAYER OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

If you've always had a good eye for details, and live in Orange County's First, Third, Fourth or Fifth Supervisorial Districts, we invite you to become a member of the Taxpayer Oversight Committee.

With the passage of Measure M in 1990 and its renewal in 2006, an oversight committee was mandated by the Orange County electorate to keep a close watch on the transportation funds generated by the half-cent sales tax which is administered by the Orange County Transportation Authority.

As a member of the Taxpayer Oversight Committee, you will ensure the transportation projects specified in Measure M are built as promised.

Currently, there is one opening for each of the First, Third, Fourth and Fifth Supervisorial Districts on the 11-person committee. Orange County citizens living in these districts may apply to serve on the committee for a three-year term. Elected and appointed officials are not eligible to serve.

The Grand Jurors Association of Orange County (GJAOC) Taxpayer Oversight Committee Selection Panel is conducting the recruitment program and will screen all applications and recommend qualified potential candidates for membership.

**The First District** consists of the cities of Garden Grove, Santa Ana, Westminster and portions of Fountain Valley.

**The Third District** consists of Orange, Tustin, Villa Park, Yorba Linda and portions of Anaheim and Irvine.

**The Fourth District** consists of the cities of Brea, Fullerton, La Habra, Placentia and portions of Anaheim and Buena Park.

**The Fifth District** consists of the cities of Aliso Viejo, Dana Point, Laguna Beach, Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel, Laguna Woods, Lake Forest, Mission Viejo, Rancho Santa Margarita, San Clemente, San Juan Capistrano and portions of Irvine.
